3.4.1 Extension activities are carried out in the neighbourhood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and impact thereof during the last five years.

The Institute coordinates and takes part in a range of public issues that are ultimately resolved through community and technical involvement. The Institute's NSS branch is doing a good job of carrying out its service-oriented courses, which cover a wide range of topics. Eventually, the NSS launched a blood donation drive, promoted Swatch Bharat, and launched a successful anti-ragging awareness campaign.

A variety of guest speakers on topics like women's safety, female entrepreneurs, and general problems are presented by the NSS unit. Every year, Yoga Day is observed to raise awareness of the advantages of yoga for promoting mental and physical health. In order to encourage healthy eating, nutrition, and general well-being, the Institute opened a "Health care centre".

The hostel has a fitness centre and health club with equipment for physical therapy. While residing and studying on campus, students are actively involved in community involvement programmes through extension programmes. By visiting surrounding schools, orphanages, and disadvantaged neighbourhoods, employees and students establish a connection with and provide assistance to the impoverished community.

The organisation hosts blood drives, medical clinics, social awareness campaigns, and other events to encourage empathy and preventive health. The organisation hosts social awareness programmes where it teaches old people who are unable to support themselves and street children how to start their own businesses, either by integrating them into senior homes or orphanages, respectively. Student chapters from non-governmental groups including Street Cause, Lee Shreyus, and Dhruvansh are present at the institution. In keeping with their broader corporate social responsibility, students volunteer in the community. The institution provides services to society through its several support systems.

Programmes including tree planting, health fairs, awareness campaigns, green initiatives, National Day celebrations, village adoption, school adoption, and other related events are regularly carried out by the institution's NSS cell. The ECO club of the institution frequently takes part in campaigns to raise awareness of various issues, such as pollution, Swachh Bharat, energy conservation, groundwater development, the prohibition on plastics, an eco-friendly Ganesha campaign, and so forth.

The festivities committee organises the religious holiday events with the goals of advancing religious tolerance and promoting the country's cultural and historical legacy. Among the festivities are Bathukamma, Diwali, Ramadan, Holi, Sankranti, Raksha Bandhan, Ganesh Pooja, Christmas, and Krishna Jayanthi.
