3.4.2 Awards and recognitions received for extension activities from government / government recognized bodies

Moonray College, in partnership with the Tulasi Hospital, encourages extension activities with committee members who are teachers and students who associate with the surrounding community for comprehensive and sustainable development.

Through its National Service Scheme (NSS) section, the institute's creative and novel stewardship initiatives assist in reaching the public through a variety of extension and outreach programmes. The main units mentioned above are operational and provide the public with an extension of the faculty's rural awareness services in terms of creating and promoting health awareness and illness management. The institute's curricular guidelines sternly enforce community service and clinical practice training, such as having students take part in public health initiatives in both urban and rural areas. The students will get excellent training in performing a range of clinical exams, nursing skills, and recognising medical crises. The main events include free medical examinations, blood-grouping tests, vital signs checks, ECG checks, mega health camps, that screen key bodily organs to determine how well physical health is operating in collaboration with NGOs. The purpose of the women's health awareness initiatives is to raise public knowledge of cleanliness and hygiene. Public education on health problems and preventative techniques is done via social awareness campaigns, which are held in schools and universities.

Effect

Students engage with the community via outreach and extension programmes, which also assist in instilling in them a sense of social, ethical, and professional responsibility for meeting societal demands. In addition, the organisation has consistently worked with NGOs to improve the community. Together with the academic institution, the activities provide the chance to establish relationships and memorandums of understanding with public and private hospitals.
