

7.1.4 Describe the Institutional efforts/initiatives in providing an inclusive environment i.e., tolerance and harmony towards cultural, regional, linguistic, communal socioeconomic and Sensitization of students and employees to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens (Within 500 words)

The institute works to create a friendly environment for students by implementing institutional initiatives. Instilling in the students a sense of equality, harmony, and peace is the aim of these kinds of events hosted by the institute. Students are mentored by academics and experienced speakers in the field of culture. Celebrations held to honor the lives and passing of famous people. Their ideas are propagated along with their philosophy of tolerance and human values. The NSS and the cultural department both provide programmes that advance enlightenment and culture. Together, villagers and students define the values that promote tolerance in society. Numerous regional celebrations are also held.

Telangana formation Day, Teachers Day, and other important national days aim to increase students' sense of inclusivity by educating them about their state and region. Students who participate in these courses learn patriotism. Students are encouraged to study and develop a love for the regional languages spoken across our country. The goal of the learning, as many as languages they can inspire students.

Literary clubs are created and Formation Day and regional festival days are marked in an effort to cultivate a love of language and tradition. There are numerous exercises, such as writing, reading, and speaking. Students are encouraged to write if they wish to get better at it. On important occasions, a variety of competitions, including debate, oratory, and essay writing, is held to promote students' linguistic attitudes. Traditional Day is celebrated at the college. All of the students might be encouraged to promote social and national harmony by incorporating them into the programmes. It is advised that students form a group to advance social justice. A variety of programmes are organized by the institution to assist students in developing their social consciousness.

The goal of the Moonray Pharmaceutical; AIDS awareness programme and rally is to increase students' knowledge of social work and increase their awareness of the various problems that society faces. It also aims to provide them with the means to address these problems. It is encouraged for people and students from all backgrounds to get involved in efforts to develop social tolerance. To improve students' awareness of financial transactions, promote financial literacy, and deepen their grasp of businesses, numerous financial projects are implemented. Every year on January 26, the day the Indian Constitution became operative, the college celebrates Republic Day on the institute's campus with tremendous pleasure. On this day, the importance of the constitution is highlighted. All college teachers and students swear an oath to protect constitutional rights and values on this day, for the sake of the country.

Every year, from January 18 to February 15, people mark Democracy Fortnight. In addition, our college honors Voters Day in an effort to increase public awareness of the importance of voting. The institute manages several programmes to uphold the rights, duties, and responsibilities that citizens have under the constitution. The institution celebrates Telangana Formation Day on June 2nd each year.

The blood donation camps were organized in tandem with the NSS special camps. Many teachers and students give blood in order to ensure that irreplaceable lives are saved. The organization also schedules health examinations for the NSS camp participants.

In addition, our institute celebrates Women's Day to honor the achievements of women throughout history.

In a same spirit, we want to increase student awareness of environmental issues by celebrating World Environment Day on June 5. The institute also organizes the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, a cleanliness campaign. Raising awareness of the importance of cleanliness is the campaign's main goal.
